- From San Ramon and Walnut Creek on Hwy 680:
Head north on Hwy 680.
Take Hwy 4 east towards Antioch and Pittsburg.
Follow the instruction below*.
- From Benicia and Martinez on Hwy 680:
Head south on Hwy 680.
Take Hwy 4 east towards Antioch and Pittsburg
Follow the instruction below*.

* Exit at Port Chicago Hwy.
Head North or towards Concord Naval Weapon Station.
Turn Right at Sussex.
Turn Left at Wellington.
