DIRECTIONS TO CITY OF SAN PABLO CIVIC CENTER, ONE ALVARADO SQUARE - 13831 SAN PABLO AVENUE

Traveling southbound on I 80:

Take San Pablo Dam Road exit. Turn right off exit heading westbound on San Pablo Dam Road. At the 3rd traffic light turn right heading northbound on San Pablo Avenue. Travel straight through the 2nd traffic light and turn left at the next left hand turn lane into Yard Birds. The Civic Center and its parking lot will be on your left hand side.

Traveling northbound on I 80:

Take San Pablo Dam Road exit. Turn left off exit onto San Pablo Dam Road heading westbound. Turn right onto San Pablo Avenue heading northbound. Travel across Church Lane and into the first left turn lane near Yardbirds parking lot. Turn left into San Pablo's Civic Center's parking lot.
