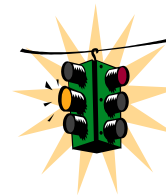


Save Our Creeks... Use GPS Technology!

Become a Creek Explorer with just three simple steps:



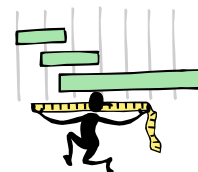
